




WEATHER AND SMOKE SEAL INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


How do I find the correct seal installation method?

Check the door label to confirm the correct sealing method. The example image on the right shows where to find this information.

Please note that if you are installing multiple Strongdor steel doors, you must check each door label individually, as specifications may vary and may require different sealing methods.






SEALING METHOD 1: UNLATCHED SMOKE RATED DOORS WITH ASTRAGAL




SEALING METHOD 2: SMOKE RATED DOORS WITHOUT ASTRAGAL



SEALING METHOD 3: ALL OTHER DOORS WITH ASTRAGAL NOT MENTIONED IN SEALING METHOD 1 OR 2




SEALING METHOD 4: ALL OTHER DOORS WITHOUT ASTRAGAL NOT MENTIONED IN SEALING METHOD 1 OR 2



 Tee Fin Seal
 Intumescent Seal

*Installation of intumescent seals are mandatory for fire rated doors.

MASTIC SEALING METHOD: WEATHER RATED DOORS



The expander jamb should be sealed with silicone (approved fire silicone if the door is fire rated).
