



Strongdor - Fire Door Roles & Responsibilities Summary

General Responsibility (Applies to Everyone)	Everyone must follow the manufacturer's fire door specification and supporting evidence. Any changes must be agreed with the specifier and approved by the manufacturer, with full documentation.
Specifier	Defines performance, design and operational requirements and communicates them clearly.
Door provider	Supplies doors and/or components strictly in line with the confirmed specification and supporting evidence.
Manufacturer	Manufactures the door to specification and ensures all supporting evidence is valid.
Supply chain	Handles and passes on components without altering the specification; ensures all components remain compatible and validated.
Door installer	Installs the fire door exactly as specified; must not alter components; must raise issues if site conditions prevent correct installation.
Relevant duty holder	Resolves issues outside installer/manufacturer control. Examples include: Principal Contractor and Principal Designer.
Partitioning / walling contractor	Prepares openings to correct size/tolerance and ensures supporting construction is validated.
