

# LPS 1673 Explained

What is it? LPS 1673 as a standard is intended to protect individuals and high-value assets from targeted attacks and violent smash-and-grab robberies. LPS 1673 provides the intended individuals an opportunity to get to a place of safety and call for help. These attacks are not intended to be subtle. Perpetrators are determined to complete their mission, whether it involves robbery or targeting an individual, without giving up. Unlike LPS 1175, LPS 1673 is an attack-rated certification, not security-rated.

Where Would Need an LPS-Rated Door? Typical applications for this range include locations at risk of targeted attacks against high-profile individuals such as politicians, celebrities or high-risk individuals. It can be suited for homes, offices and safe rooms in domestic properties.

What do I need to know? This standard, whilst it uses similar tools to the LPS 1175 standard, provides protection against a more violent and relentless attack. The table below shows the ratings available under this standard. The letter denotes the tool kit used and the number provides the seconds it achieved this rating, unlike LPS 1175, which is rated in minutes.
