

Blue Cross Ipswich.

Opened in 2016, the new Blue Cross complex in Wherstead near Ipswich was designed to meet the needs of sick and homeless pets.

Light and spacious, the animal rescue centre is capable of caring for 80 puppies in a new unit, while doubling the charities capacity in the Suffolk area.

Air circulation and security were primary concerns in the design of the buildings. Protecting vulnerable animals while maintaining good ventilation, meant that the architects looked to louvred door panels to satisfy both needs.
