Based in Bristol, Knowle DGE Learning Centre is a vibrant and aspirational learning community for young people with additional educational needs.

Formerly known as the Florence Brown School, the centre moved to its current, purpose-built site in the summer of 2010. Constructed under Building Schools for the Future programme, the school typically has a roll of about 150 students who benefit from the high staff ratios and superb facilities.
